











Fig. 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values




FR4 PCB; single-sided copper; tin-plated; mounting pad for collector  $6 \text{ cm}^2$

Fig. 7. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values








**Fig. 8. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values**




**Fig. 9. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values**



**Fig. 10. Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values**




**Fig. 11. Base-emitter voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**





**Fig. 12. Base-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**





**Fig. 13. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**





**Fig. 14. Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values**








Fig. 18. Package outline SOT223 (SC-73)




Fig. 19. Reflow soldering footprint for SOT223 (SC-73)




Fig. 20. Wave soldering footprint for SOT223 (SC-73)
